AWU reps attended an EBA meeting yesterday, to continue negotiations for a new agreement with MHPS to cover their workforce.

AWU members have put forward many claims, most of which are still being discussed.

MHPS have agreed to the AWU's claim to move the expiration date of the next agreement to the middle of the year.

This will mean that casuals employed by MHPS will be more likely to be employed by the company when the next EBA is being negotiated, and will have a better chance to get involved in the EBA process.

The next meeting is scheduled to take place on Tuesday 9<sup>th</sup> December.
